Used to produce high quality images for indoor and outdoor signage, interior designs and displays, **Dickson Digital Media Fabrics** are manufactured with 50% fewer raw materials and are free of PVC, phthalates, phosphates, formaldehyde and glycol-ether. During the production process, these fabrics have a lower energy fabrication cost leading to an 80% energy savings. Additionally, the fabrics do not release volatile organic compounds (VOC) that contribute to air pollution. Dickson Digital Media Fabrics are packaged in recycled cardboard, and require less fuel for transportation due to the material's light weight.

Other green digital media fabric choices include Sunbrella® Inkjet White, Poly Oxford White and Poly Light White – all part of Glen Raven's **Vivitex™ line of printable fabrics**. Specifically designed for use on solvent-based and UV curable printers, the Vivitex line is woven and coated in the U.S., with no PVCs, heavy metals or formaldehyde used during production. The coating on the products is non-chemically reactive and none of the coating ends up in landfills. Unused residual fuels and solvents are recycled. The fabrics are shipped in 100% recyclable packaging material.

The **Ultra Lifestyle Collection** is a group of three luxurious simulated leather marine interior fabrics that are formulated to resist fading and spotting over extended periods of direct sunlight. Durable and scratch resistant, these fabrics are produced using environmentally conscious technology and are void of plasticizers, heavy metals, formaldehyde, pyroxylin, Bisphenol A (BPA) and persistent organic pollutants (POPs).

Phifertex® 100% Marquésa® casual furniture fabrics are made of an environmentally friendly material that is lightweight, yet strong and durable for cushion applications. The fabrics in the 100% Marquésa collection are composed entirely of Marquésa yarn, the only yarn – synthetic or natural – that is constructed from post-industrial waste by-product. The Marquésa yarn requires lower energy and water consumption, and the process yields little by-product, allowing the least waste and environmental impact of any synthetic fabric. The fabric is recyclable and can be re-extruded up to 10 times.

We also carry an extensive line of **Sunbrella®** and **SheerWeave®** fabrics that have been certified by the GREENGUARD® Environmental Institute (GEI) as low-emitting products. Sunbrella furniture fabrics and select SheerWeave fabrics have earned the GREENGUARD Certification which provides reassurance that these fabrics do not emit harmful air pollutants.

SheerWeave Styles that have been GREENGUARD certified include SheerWeave 2000, 2100, 2360, 2390, 2410, 2500, 2703 and 2710. SheerWeave fabrics were the first window shade fabrics ever to be certified.

Both Sunbrella furniture fabrics and the SheerWeave window shade fabrics also received the GREENGUARD Children & SchoolsSM Certification, which requires that products meet even more stringent standards to help limit pollutant exposure in schools and other settings that serve children and other sensitive individuals.
